#### Important information

- Applications for Year 7 entry to selective high schools in 2022 will be accepted from Tuesday 13 October 2020 to Monday 16 November 2020.
- Parents must apply online at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7">https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7</a>
- All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test to be held on Thursday 11 March 2021.

Key changes to the selective high school placement process for entry in 2022:

- The department has developed a new application system that will give parents a more interactive experience.
- The new system enables parents to make updates and add attachments even after an application is submitted.
- Parents can also communicate directly with the Team through the system's 'messages' feature.
- From 2021 the Selective high School Placement Test will use a new framework which will have a greater emphasis on thinking skills, mathematical reasoning and problem solving.
- The placement test, developed by Cambridge Assessment, aims to give every student the opportunity to prove their potential regardless of their background.
- The changes to the test are in response to the findings of the 2018 Review of Selective Education Access Report commissioned by the NSW Department of Education.

#### **Dance Fever**

This term "Dance Fever Multi Sport" are teaching the Dance Curriculum to all our students from Kindergarten to Year 6. Dance Fever is compliant with the departments expectations of external providers presenting in these COVID times. They have a COVID safe plan and appropriate infection control training. Students will stay in their class or stage group. Dancing will occur on Wednesdays for a 40min per session. The "Dance Program 2020" is curriculum designed to teach children a variety of dances, including individual, partner and group routines as well as maintaining a strong focus on the elements of dance. We have run this program with this company for the last two year and it has been extremely popular with students and teachers.

- Enrolments into **local** schools only
- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- Children who live in NSW.


